Lifetime Member

According to Section 3.1(c) of the USCRA Bylaws, “A ‘Lifetime Member’ shall be defined as any court reporter who: (i) held an appointment as an official court reporter under 28 USC Section 753 for at least ten (10) years; (ii) has separated from such appointment; (iii) has been a dues-paying member of USCRA for at least ten (10) years; (iv) has given distinguished service to this Association as determined by the Board of Directors; (v) has been elected as a Lifetime Member by majority of the voting members present at the annual meeting of the members; and (vi) shall not be required to pay dues.”
